

# Previously at Clifton College: Clifton Robinsons M1 2 - 1 Ashmoor



In front of a packed Stade De Clifton College the game started at a frenetic pace with Ashmoor applying early pressure, Clifton looking slightly nervy with many new faces making their club debuts. That trend continued into the 2nd quarter, with Ashmoor creating numerous D penetrations and a resulting short corner narrowly missing the target. Clifton showed flickers of light with some sharp counter attacks but Ashmoor's pressure was soon told after a goal mouth scramble resulted in an Ashmoor forward tucking the ball home to make it 0-1.

With some stern words at half time, the 3rd quarter was a complete turn around. Early Clifton pressure lead to Clifton's first short corner of the game. Step up, the Giant of a man Rory Thorburn. 

## Clifton Robinsons L2 1 - 1 Basingstoke


On an extremely wet and windy day Clifton Robinsons L2's travelled to Basingstoke. Having only played once before due to Covid it was likely to be a tightly contested game.


