Vitality Women's Premier Division

East Grinstead and Wimbledon meet in the standout Vitality Women's Premier Division encounter on Saturday. The crunch clash between two of the top four sides forms part of a double header for East Grinstead, with the men's side also in action at Saint Hill.

However, it is Hampstead & Westminster's superb start to the season which shows no sign of abating ahead of a pivotal month in the top flight. With seven straight wins and a nine-point advantage at the top of the league, the Londoners have a home clash with Beeston, who currently hold that all-important sixth place in the top flight. Saturday's match certainly looks set to be an interesting affair. Beeston travel to the capital following a fine 4-0 victory over a stuttering Buckingham last weekend. And they will aim to exploit weaknesses in Hampstead's defence, which has shipped five goals in their last three matches.

Two of those goals came last weekend when Loughborough Students continued their penchant for rallying performances after conceding early goals, although the side co-coached by Sarah Kelleher and Kate Richardson-Walsh held on for a 3-2 victory. Loughborough face a stern test in their quest for a top six place when Brett Holland's side take on a double header weekend. They host Swansea on Saturday before travelling to Wimbledon for a Sunday lunchtime push back.

Meanwhile, Clifton Robinsons, unbeaten in three matches, are at home to University of Birmingham.

Buckingham and Holcombe, who have both endured losing form, will look to bounce back when they face each other at Stowe School.

Previously at Coombe Dingle: Clifton Robinsons 5 - 4 Loughborough Students

This week's match was an important one for both Clifton Robinsons and Loughborough, with both teams looking to win 3 points at Coombe Dingle. The game started with Clifton on the front foot and a smashing debut Premier League goal from Tilly Edwards put the home side in front. This was followed quickly by another first goal in the Prem, this time scored by Clemmie Houlden who perfectly deflected a ball into the bottom corner from a beautiful delivery by Holly Munro. With momentum on their side Clifton had a very fluid run of play, ending with a corker of a finish from a reverse stick hit into the back of the net from Catherine Macaulay to put the home side up 3-0 at half-time.

After half time an early break from Clifton Robinsons resulted in a short corner, which was converted by Abi Porter with a deflection through the legs. Loughborough then found a spell of momentum and some beautiful build up plays lead to them converting 3 goals in quick succession from some tidy penalty corners and a field goal. Clifton responded when Macaulay delivered a peach of a ball to Claire Thomas who deflected the ball into the goal from in front of the goalie to restore a 2 goal cushion.

As the tension rose with 8 minutes to go, Loughborough scored another goal and continued to put pressure on the Clifton defence. However they held onto their 5-4 lead and despite a card in the final quarter managed to seal the win and take the 3 points. A well earned rest follows this weekend, and time to refresh before making a big push in the final 4 fixtures.



Last Time Away:

Clifton Robinsons L1 2 - 1 Swansea

After playing 4 matches and having a lot of draws to start off this season, the Clifton Robinsons Ladies' 1s headed up to Swansea hoping to get their first win. The match started with Clifton on the front foot and some lovely passages of play led to several short corners. Finally, one was deflected into the left corner of the goal by Ash Mainwaring off a left slip delivery from Holly Munro. This early goal gave Clifton Robinsons some more momentum and a quick counter attack lead to a big foul in the Swansea's D and a penalty stroke for the visiting side. The flick was classily converted by Claire Thomas and CRHC took a 2 goal lead.

The whistle blew for half time with Clifton 2-0 up, however a slightly rocky two minutes after the break meant Swansea got one goal back after a baseline drive and a tap in from the penalty spot. Both teams fought hard for another goal in the rest of the second half but neither team could find the back of the net so Clifton Robinsons came away with the win and 3 points. The first win of the season leaves CRHC in mid-table at the halfway stage before the mid-season split.

Last time out:

Oxford Hawks 4 - 0 Clifton Robinsons L2

The CRHC Ladies' 2s faced a tough match away against Oxford Hawks 1st XI on Saturday 30th October. Within the first minute of the match, tactical play in the D gave Clifton a penalty corner, but – despite a powerful strike – the 2s were denied an early lead. Action moved quickly to the other end of the pitch with a superb save from Sophie Trigg to keep the score level, but then a converted penalty corner took Oxford 1-0 up. Only a few minutes later, another penalty corner meant that the 2s ended the quarter with a two-goal deficit.

Nonetheless, Clifton did anything but let their heads go down. The second quarter started with strong attacking play from the 2s, including a saved shot on goal and another penalty corner that the Oxford defence kept out. Oxford upped their pressure, but nothing about the 2s was going to make it easy for them. The pressure kept coming, though, and 12 minutes in, another converted penalty corner put the score at 3-0 at half time. To the 2s' absolute credit that's exactly the way it stayed for the majority of the second half, with our team showing formidable penalty corner defence, regardless of the configuration Oxford threw at them. A final 15th-minute corner to Oxford finished the match with a 4-0 loss for CRHC L2s – but the girls can be proud of the commitment, grit and determination they demonstrated in the face of a well-oiled, tight performance from the home team.



Back in Bristol:

Firebrands 0 - 0 Clifton Robinsons L2

CRHC Ladies 2s played an evenly contested derby against local side Bristol Firebrands 1s on Saturday 23rd October. With Firebrands presently sitting top of the Conference West league table, CRHC L2s knew they would have their work cut out.

Both teams were persistent in attack and defence in a fast-paced first quarter of end-to-end hockey. After the short break, Clifton came out fighting hard, maintaining great pressure throughout the remainder of the first half, moving the ball skilfully throughout the pitch, keeping Firebrands at bay and just never quite finding the back of the net.

A chip over the Firebrands goal keeper from Martha Barratt about 10 minutes into the third quarter just skimmed wide of the top left corner of the goal, and it seemed Clifton had fire in their bellies and a shift in scoreline was surely only moments away. At about 12 minutes in, Firebrands picked up a loose ball and took it into the D, but the shot was superbly saved by Sophie Trigg to keep everything level at 0-0 all the way into the final quarter of the match.

Cheers went up from the Clifton fans as 2 minutes into the final leg, the ladies won a penalty corner – but no goal this time. In what was characteristic of a see-saw match, a return penalty corner for Firebrands 6 minutes later still produced no change in the scoreline. As the minutes drew to a close, Firebrands were awarded three penalty corners back to back – each brilliantly and fiercely defended – the last as the final whistle blew. A no-score draw sees the CRHC L2s move up one position in the Conference West league table with corresponding upward motion in belief and spirit following this more-than satisfying draw against the league leaders.
