# **Clifton Robinsons W1 - Holcombe**

The wait is finally over as we switch our attention from the international game to domestic hockey. This weekend will see the start of new campaigns up and down the country, and many eyes will be on the 'Match of the Week' as newly-promoted University of Nottingham make the short trip across University Boulevard to face near-neighbours Beeston. The University of Nottingham will look ahead to their first ever Premier Division match with confidence after a promising pre-season and an undefeated promotion-winning season. Beeston had mixed fortunes at home last season (4 wins, 1 draw, 5 losses) and will be looking to lay down an early marker and take the bragging rights of Nottingham hockey.

Reigning Champions Surbiton will, yet again, look to defend their crown as they make their first trip north to Loughborough Students, who are seeking to end their six-game losing streak. Surbiton are buoyed by the return of experienced players Giselle Ansley and Hannah Martin, both returning after a successful season in the Netherlands, but will be without influential stalwarts Georgie Twigg and Emily Defroand. With a combined 16 years of service to the club, both players have announced this week they are stepping away from the sport.

Clifton Robinsons welcome a new-look Holcombe side to Coombe Dingle. The Kent club, with England men's forward Nick Bandurak now at the helm, have no fewer than eight new signings. Clifton Robinsons have also had a busy summer with seven new players joining. After a busy pre-season, both sides will be hoping their new stars gel well and hit the ground running. Last season's Division One South winners, Reading, who welcome Wimbledon to Sonning Lane, will be looking to re-establish themselves in the Premier Division after a long hiatus. Both teams have had busy off-seasons, with Great Britain and England stars Shona McCallin and Lizzie Neal joining Reading, whilst Anna Toman and Flora Peel returned to Wimbledon after playing overseas. Wimbledon also strengthened their ranks with Irish World Cup silver medalist Gillian Pinder from Pembroke.

After finishing the last campaign in second place, Hampstead & Westminster will be looking to go one better this season as they look to hit the ground running against Buckingham. Buckingham, who had an excellent final surge in last year's Phase 2, winning four of their previous five matches, will need to be at their best to stop Hampstead and their new marquee signings. Two additions on pitch and one off the field have had the hockey media talking, as Lily Owsley and Anna O'Flanagan bolster the attack while Helen Richardson-Walsh joins the coaching team.

University of Birmingham will be looking to avenge defeat when they travel to West Sussex, eager to turn the tables on East Grinstead, who beat the West Midlands side 7-0 in their last encounter. With an influx of new players on both sides, this will look very different to previous meetings.
