Clifton Robinsons W1 - East Grinstead 22nd October 2022 - 12pm

League leaders Surbiton are travelling to Wimbledon for only the second time in Premier Division history, where one team's form will end. Home side Wimbledon hopes to end Surbiton's fine start and 100% record to the season, whilst the visitors will be eager to inflict the first defeat of the season to the west London side.

Second-placed side Clifton Robinsons will be hoping for favours from Wimbledon so they can close the gap on the leaders. Sitting just three points behind but in awe of Surbiton's far superior goal difference (+17 compared to +5), Clifton Robinsons would need to quadruple their biggest-ever Premier Division win against visitors East Grinstead and hope for a Wimbledon success to go top.

Loughborough Students head to London, still searching for their first win of the season. Things do not get any easier when they face Hampstead & Westminster, having never beaten the hosts at the Paddington Recreation Ground.

Separated by two points, Holcombe hope to continue their excellent form against Beeston when the East Midlands club is in Kent. Having won all three games by three-goal margins, keeping two clean sheets in the process, Holcombe will welcome Beeston to Holcombe Park for the first time since September 2019. Gaining their first point of the season in last week's 0-0 draw with Holcombe,

Reading will entertain the University of Birmingham at Sonning Lane. Making their first trip to Reading since February 2017, when Erica Sanders' hat trick was enough to give Birmingham a 3-2 win, the visitors will be looking to continue their winning run in Berkshire. Having won the last three away meetings, the first of those three, Anna Toman scored the only goal in November 2014 to give the West Midlands students their first top-flight win at Reading.

Buckingham, eager to avoid their fifth straight defeat, travel to the Nottingham Hockey Centre to line up against the University of Nottingham.

Last Time Out:

Clifton Robinsons W13-0 Beeston

Clifton Robinsons were back at their home ground, Coombe Dingle to play an undefeated Beeston Ladies side full of confidence. Clifton have found Beeston a difficult team to gain points from losing both home and away to them last season. As expected the game started off at a high intensity with immediate circle entries from both sides, Beeston having the better of chances with a dangerous cross just edging past the Clifton back post with no Beeston player to tap it in. The close encounter by Beeston seemed to shock Clifton into action with a flurry of purposeful attacks leading to the home sides first goal coming in the 17th minute just before the end of the 1st Quarter with Clifton defender Holly Munroe delivering a pin point pass into the attacking circle for Phoebe Richards to dart in front of the Beeston defence to deflect the ball into the bottom corner. With only 1 goal to separate both teams it was a tight game and Clifton were trying to find a moment to increase their lead which they did in the 26th minute with a penalty corner where Kat Gierak stepped up for a straight strike off the top, this was Gieraks 1st goal for Clifton Robinsons after joining the Bristol side this season. The second half saw the umpire award the away side a penalty stroke after some last ditch defending by Clifton to scramble the ball away in a packed defensive circle. Clifton Goalkeepers Aline De Visser confidently took her place and pulled out a player of the match worthy stick save to keep Beeston out. As the away side continued to step up to try and salvage some points out of the game, Eloise Laity took advantage of the extra space behind the Beeston defence with a blistering run down the right hand side to slip the ball across goal for Abi Porter to tap in from a yard out.
