The game commenced with a minute's silence in memory of Craig Keegan who sadly passed away following a very difficult 18-month battle with Acute Lymphoblastic Lymphoma. The former Beeston and Belper coach was assistant coach with the GB Women when they picked up Olympic Gold in 2016.




